Griswold – Albert Romelus Bordeleau, 96, of Bitgood Road passed away Thursday, May 8, 2020 at W.W. Backus Hospital. As one of 12 children, Albert was born January 31, 1924 in Fitchburg, MA, son to the late Patrick and Emilia (Sylvestre) Bordeleau. On May 14, 1949 he married Helen (Bonchuk) Bordeleau and shared nearly 71 years of marriage together. Albert and Helen were active communicants of St Mary's church. She survives him.

He later continued his service in the Army Reserves and retired after 27 total years of service. He also worked for many years for the Town of Griswold maintaining the voter machines. Albert was an avid UCONN Women's Basketball fan and spent many enjoyable hours watching their games and proudly displayed the Husky flag. He was best known for his "Outstanding" response and infectious smile with which he greeted everyone.
